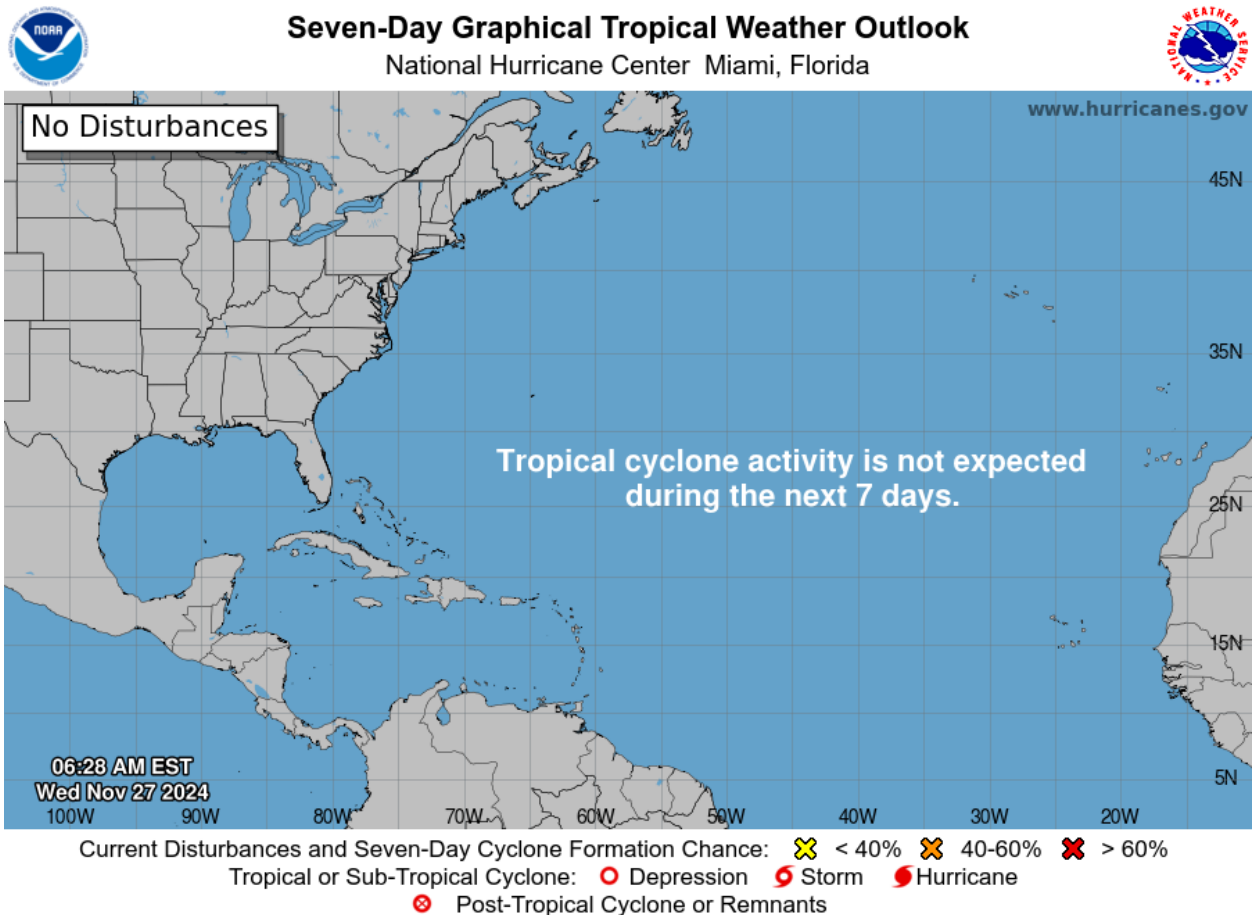

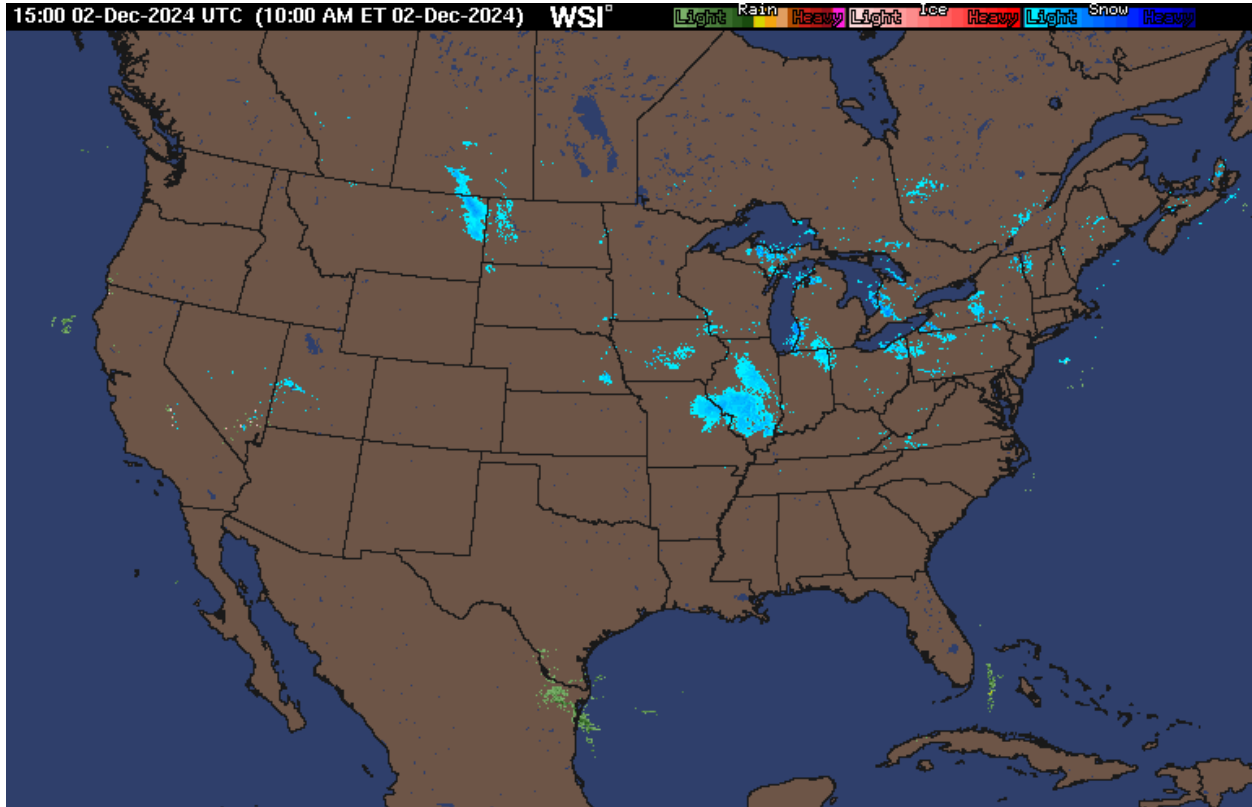

TODAY

Northeast winds 10 to 15 knots with gusts up to 20 knots, diminishing to 5 to 10 knots this afternoon. Waves 2 to 3 feet this morning, then 1 foot or less.

TONIGHT

North winds around 5 knots, increasing to 10 to 15 knots with gusts up to 20 knots after midnight. Waves 1 foot or less, then around 2 feet after midnight.

TUESDAY

Northeast winds 10 to 15 knots. Waves 2 to 3 feet.

TUESDAY NIGHT

Northeast winds 5 to 10 knots. Waves around 2 feet.

WEDNESDAY

East winds 5 to 10 knots, becoming southeast in the afternoon. Waves around 2 feet in the morning, then 1 foot or less.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT

South winds 5 to 10 knots. Waves around 2 feet. A slight chance of showers in the evening, then a chance of showers with a slight chance of thunderstorms after midnight.

THURSDAY

Southwest winds 5 to 10 knots, becoming northwest in the afternoon. Waves

around 2 feet. A chance of thunderstorms. Showers likely, mainly in the morning.

THURSDAY NIGHT

North winds 10 to 15 knots. Waves 2 to 4 feet. A chance of showers with a slight chance of thunderstorms in the evening.

FRIDAY

Northeast winds 10 to 15 knots. Waves 2 to 4 feet.

FRIDAY NIGHT

Northeast winds around 10 knots. Waves 2 to 3 feet. A slight chance of showers after midnight.

Winds and waves higher in and near thunderstorms.
